

BURN KEROSENE & & INSTEAD OF GASOLENE




EVERY MAN who runs a steam carriage dislikes the gasolene fire. Even if he has had no trouble the "National Kerosene Oil Burner" we offer a means for burning a safe oil in a safe way, and for getting greater heat at smaller cost. Furthermore, the burner we offer is one that has been tested out and which will do all we claim for it. and fulfill every requirement of the most exacting automobile owner. We supply the burners ready for attachment, or will adjust them on carriages sent us for that purpose. We have careful, experienced workmen, who thoroughly understand the business, and shop is equipped with up-to-date tools, machinery and power. In general appearance the burner is similar to all automobile burners in that the main vaporizing coil lies across the burner, and discharges the gas into a mixing tube, and the oil is fed to the burner under pressure provided by a pump worked by the engine; but the pilot light is operated at a much lower pressure than the main burner. This pilot light will run for hours without attention, and keeps up vaporization to light the main fire. One or both may be operated from the seat, if desired.

The burner is fully enclosed with the pilot light, and the flame, gases, etc., can find no exit except through the boiler and stack.

There is no "back-firing."

It will not soot up the boiler, as it never smokes.

The wind does not affect it, and it never blows out.



This simple device will oil your engine cylinders steadily, regularly, mile after mile without the slightest attention so long as there is a drop of oil in the oiler; a by-pass from the water pump gives the pressure in the tank and forces the oil into the cylinders. Should a larger quantity of oil be wanted at any one time, a valve on the opposite end will put it in for you in a jiffy. The only perfect cylinder oiler on the market.
